1. Understand that our sin separates us from God	God cannot stomach our sins.	Romans 3:23
2. Understand why Jesus died	The penalty for sin of any kind is eternal death. We could not pay our own penalty and still live.	Romans 6:23; 5:8
3. Accept the Resurrection of Christ	The evidence is overwhelming. The resurrection proves who He is <u>and</u> proves there is life beyond the grave.	1 Thessalonians 4:13-14 1 Peter 1:3; 1 Corinthians 15:3-8
4. Put total trust in Christ	Trust is <i>faith</i> . Call Jesus "Lord."	Romans 5:1; 1 Peter 1:8-9
5. Change our mind about wilfully sinning	<i>Repentance</i> is a change of mind that leads to a change in our conduct.	Acts 2:38; 3:19; 20:21; 2 Corinthians 7:10
6. <u>Then</u> be immersed in water for God's gifts	In <i>baptism</i> , we identify with Jesus' death, burial and resurrection. This is <i>not</i> optional.	Mark 16:16; Acts 2:38; 22:16; 1 Peter 3:21
7. Continue faithfully as a child of God	Learning, church attendance, the Lord's Supper and prayer. These items of worship are not optional, either.	Acts 2:42; Hebrews 10:25 1 Peter 1:13-19
